## Installation & Finishing

- **Fastening Hardware:** Coated, narrow, crown staples are recommended over smooth staples and penetrate MDF boards more consistently. Use a fine wire gauge staple or nail to avoid splitting. Nails or staples should not be driven within 3/4" of any corner. We recommend ring-shank or "T" nails, which reduce the chance of puckering or dimpling around the nail head. For applications requiring screws, pre-drill pilot holes 85-90% of the root diameter of the selected screw. Do not over-tighten screws to prevent stripping. We recommend sheet metal screws or special MDF designed screws. Avoid using wood screws.
- **Tools:** Pneumatic fastening systems are recommended. Use 100 psi air pressure to properly counter-sink most fastenings. A conventional hammer and nail set also work well with MDF. For cutting, use a carbide tip saw blade.
- **Painting/Finishing:** Pre-primed mouldings readily accept both water- and solvent-based finishing coats which may be applied with a brush, roller or spray application.

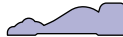

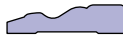
